The beds are dressed with corn husk mattresses supported on a platform of ropes stretched between the bed rails. A "feather tick" is placed on top of the mattress. This is a soft feather filled pad covered in a tightly woven cloth referred to as "ticking." Hand woven linen sheets and a quilt for the Inn's collection complete the fully dressed bed. One of the sets of sheets has a date of 1840 embroidered on them - a feature rarely seen on more everyday items.

Another feature on the third floor is an alcove with a writing desk. so travelers could post a letter from the post office located in the Tap Room on the first floor of the Inn. Nelson Hawks was also the postmaster.

All of these updating tasks, including the publishing of this newsletter are performed by a group of dedicated enthusiasts who volunteer their time and effort to preserve our local history and make it available to the community.

Also, don't miss the 19th century Wag-onthe Wall clock located just inside the Inn's front entrance.
